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Dr. Dooley formerly held a position at Pfizer Central Research where he was director of Pfizer's Clinical Pathology Laboratory from 1973 to 1983; director of Dianon Cancer Laboratories from 1984 to 1988; and director of Biomedical Associates Group Laboratories from 1988 to 1995, a chain of twelve clinical laboratories throughout New York and New England. In 2004, he was awarded the Bayer Diagnostic Prize from the American Association for Clinical Chemistry. He has published over fifty scientific papers on diagnostic medicine and biochemistry, three books, and over 75 monographs on molecular medicine, diagnostic testing and life science sectors. Dr. Dooley speaks regularly at scientific and business conferences throughout the world.
